To create each animal, carefully press out the model, fold it in half and fold and hook the tabs together.

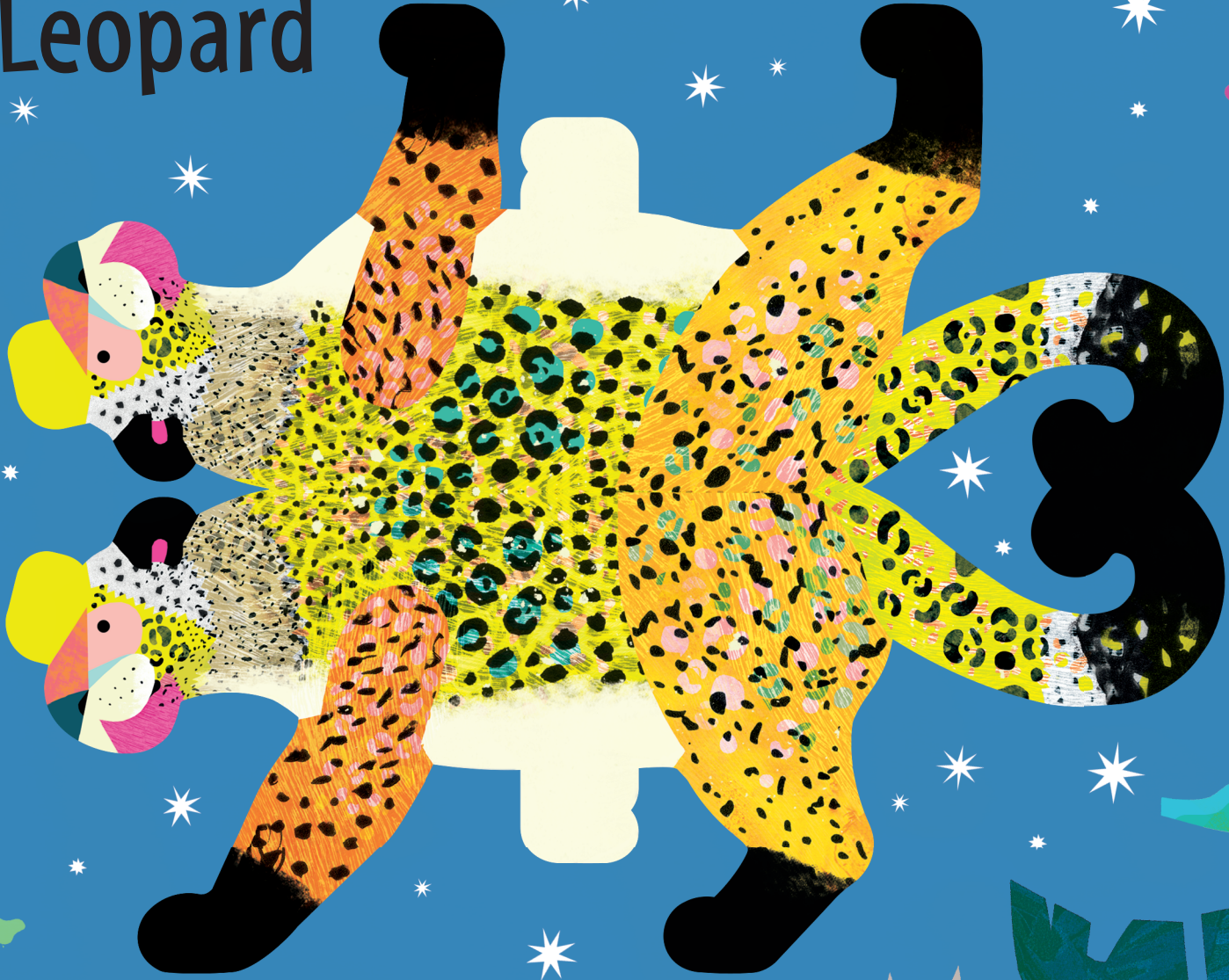
Some tabs are marked with a red dot. Fold these tabs flat against the inside of the model before you hook them together, so they are hidden from view.

Colour in the reverse side of each animal if you like. The model can be folded in either direction, depending on which side you want to show.

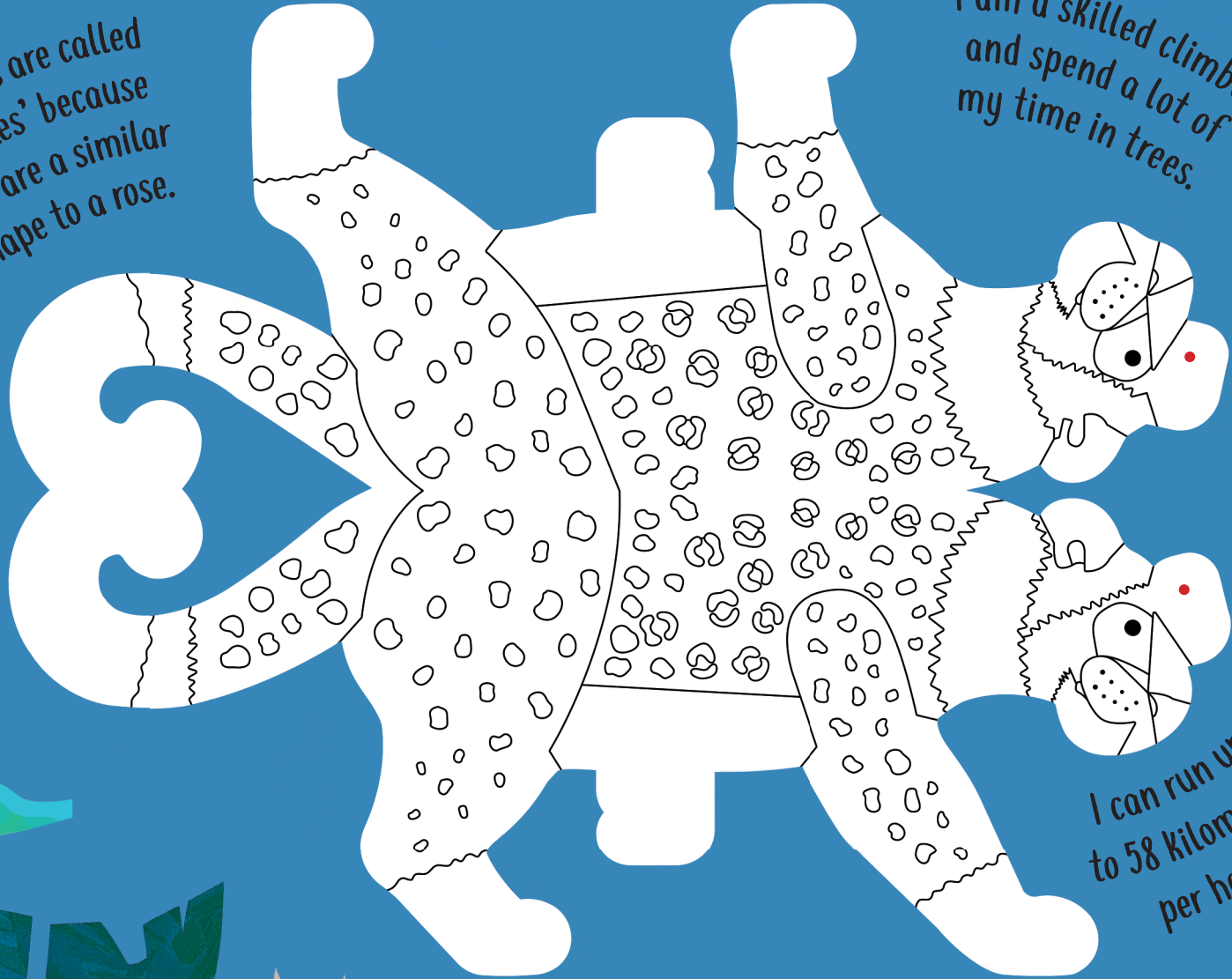
There are two scenes at the back of the book to display your animals against. Carefully remove these pages and fold along the lines to create colourful backgrounds.
