MICHAEL PORTILLO is a British journalist, broadcaster, and former member of parliament and cabinet minister in the Conservative party. Since retiring from active politics in 2005, Michael has pursued a successful media career. He is a regular guest on BBC1's political discussion programme This Week, and has made a range of documentaries, including BBC2's Great British Railway Journeys and Great Continental Railway Journeys. A long-serving member of the panel in Radio 4's The Moral Maze, Michael has also written a regular column for The Sunday Times and contributes to a number of other newspapers and magazines.
